

Designation: Teaching Fellow (TF)

Department: China Studies

Location: Ashoka University Campus, Sonipat, Haryana

We are looking to fill a position for Teaching Fellows for the Monsoon 2026 semester. The TFs will teach in “Introduction to the Study of China” Course.

Roles and Responsibilities:

The TF is expected to support faculty in delivering the course. The TF’s responsibilities include

- Leading Discussions Sections of an hour every week.
- Keep weekly office hours to meet students
- Assist in conducting and grading all assignments

Qualifications:

- To be considered for the Teaching Fellow position, a candidate must hold at minimum a master’s degree from any recognized university or institute and have an excellent academic record.
- Under exceptional circumstances, a candidate holding a bachelor’s degree from Ashoka University can be considered for a TF position, but only after a gap of two regular semesters post-graduation. Candidates from outside Ashoka holding only a bachelor’s degree cannot be hired as TFs unless the Dean of Academic Affairs grants an exception.
- Candidates pursuing a Ph.D. degree at Ashoka University may be eligible if they have submitted their thesis or are nearing completion (as set by the department). They will receive either a stipend or remuneration, but not both. If hired as Teaching Fellows, Part-time Ph.D. students of Ashoka University will receive remuneration as per university TF Guidelines.

Accommodation: The University helps TFs find accommodation on campus (upon availability) or in the campus- vicinity (TDI Lake Grove) but does not cover the rent charges.

Compensation: As per the standard TF policy of the University.
